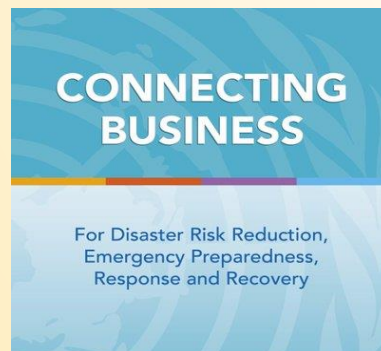

2


Supports national level private sector networks / platforms to fully engage in national disaster risk management mechanisms and to increase their resilience against emergencies.

Promotes the adoption of best practice policies and standards by businesses, governments and other actors.




The Connecting Business initiative

- ▶ Launched at the WHS in Istanbul, 23-24 May 2016
 - ▶ Supporting the creation and strengthening of business networks in 40 countries by 2010
 - ▶ Currently working in Fiji, the Philippines, Myanmar, Sri Lanka, Madagascar, Kenya, Nigeria, Turkey, Haiti and Mexico
 - ▶ Operating the Connecting Business Global Portal
 - ▶ Generating and disseminating best practice
 - ▶ Building resilience in all contexts - natural disasters, climate change adaptation, conflict and displacement crises

Connecting Business Network Members

- ▶ Coordinate business engagement with Governments, NGOs, UN organizations and others before, during and after crises
 - ▶ Strengthen the resilience of businesses to withstand and recover from emergencies
 - ▶ Integrate the private sector into national disaster management planning, processes and programs
 - ▶ Match private sector capacities and resources to needs before, during and after emergencies
 - ▶ Act as a local entry point for the private sector
 - ▶ Map and monitor private sector engagement
 - ▶ Build and operate a local information database



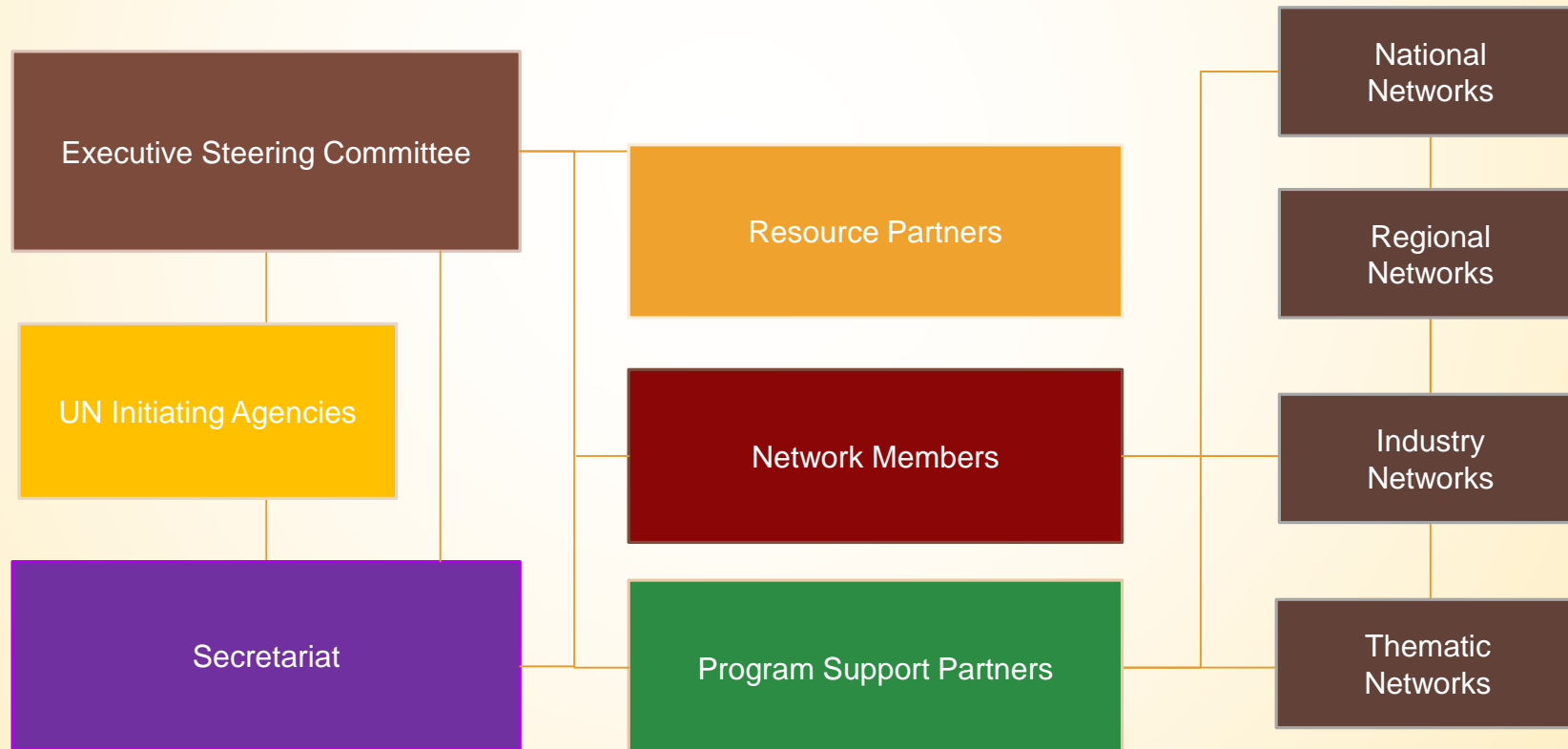
